INVISIBLE CHAINS SAFETE MUCHAVE

Societal structures can act as "invisible chains," subtly shaping behaviors, opportunities and perceptions through norms, cultural beliefs, institutional frameworks, and economic restrictions, often without conscious awareness.

How do social norms and cultural beliefs limit individual freedom and opportunities?

In what ways do institutional structures like education and law reinforce existing hierarchies?
How can recognizing these "invisible chains" help in addressing social inequalities and promoting social justice?

Safete Muchave is a contemporary dance performer of Mozambican origin who has always been passionate about movement and expressive dances. His journey began with martial arts and traditional Mozambican dances. He felt the need to fuse the various forms of artistic expression that he had accumulated through his life journey in order to create a hybrid body and provide a space for self-reflection, sharing ideas, and experiences with other bodies.
